Important Drop-Off and Pick-Up Information

- Do not give them money, as this is encouraging them to come back.
- If you see someone walking toward you and you are still in your car, please remain in your car until they are no longer in the area or **call the office and we will notify Mr. Bill**. The office number is **205 252-5060**.
- If someone is close to your car or walking around the area, please remain in the building and **let someone at the front desk know**.
- Do not assume that because you have a child in tow, they will not approach you.
- If you ever feel concerned/threatened (not just in our parking lot), you can call 205 328-9311. This is the non-emergency number for the police department, but if you feel it is a true emergency do not hesitate to call 911.
- Most importantly, be aware of your surroundings!
