

Reminders for Withdrawing Your Child

You may be making plans to withdraw your child in the coming months. The following are reminders based on information from page 11 in the Parent Handbook.

Tuition for a full month is due, even if you withdraw your child before the end of a month. Tuition is not prorated.

- * Turn in at the front desk a 30-day written notice of withdrawal.
- * Tell your child's teachers about the withdrawal date.

Security deposits will be refunded if the 30-day written notice is given and there are no outstanding debts to the Center.
