COMMUNITY APPLICATION

The Harris Early Learning Center (HELC) is a state-of-the-art early learning facility that serves over 200 children from the ages of six weeks through K-4/5. The HELC was a previous project of the *Birmingham Urban Revitalization Partnership, Inc.* (a consortium of city government, business, and civic leaders), and is now owned by Auburn University. The HELC is accredited with the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), which defines and enforces high standards of quality in childcare such as training, teacher qualifications, and teacher/child ratios. The HELC welcomes children from all backgrounds. The HELC will not discriminate against anyone on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin or disability.

Spaces for children are reserved primarily for employees of sponsoring employers (see attached list of sponsors). Community spaces are offered on a limited basis when they are not needed immediately for an employee of a corporate sponsor. Upon enrollment of a community applicant, there is no promise or guarantee, oral or written, that enrollment will be continued after the end of the current school year. We pledge to continue enrollment if at all possible.

Parents will be notified if their child has been accepted. If a space is offered, you will have one week to accept or decline the position. The annual enrollment fee, security deposit, and annual supply fee will be due upon accepting a space. At that time an official start date will be determined (a minimum of one week after accepting the space). Prior to starting parents will need to make an appointment to receive an orientation and complete the necessary paperwork.

Corporate sponsored children are given priority for space availability and may pay a corporate tuition rate. Sponsorship does not guarantee a space. Each sponsor reserved a specific number of spaces to be used by their employees. If those reserved spaces are all being used, spaces to that particular sponsor will be offered at a community rate.
